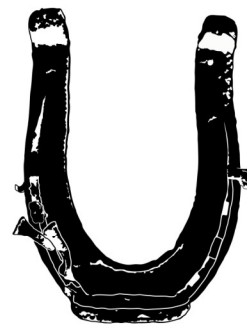
Food Pairings
